

Entry for Local Charities Award

This award recognizes the chapter which gives the largest per member monetary contributions from funds raised during year to local charitable causes or community service projects in the community, city, or county in which it is located. **Do not include National Living Endowment Giving**

Eligibility requirements:

Only chapter money raised from fund raising projects, regular funds, grants, corporate sponsors, and individual donations are considered. .

District

1. Be "in good standing" (all national, regional, and district dues and fees paid).
2. Be a 100% Living Endowment Chapter (\$40.00 per member) for the award year.

National

- 1.- 2. Same as above.
3. The entry must be selected as the District Local Charities winner with the award presented at the Regional Fall Conference immediately preceding the National Conference.

Judging and awards

The judges may declare ties if the highest average per member contribution is the same in more than one chapter.

District level

Judges: to be selected by the District Governor. Award: district banner medallion for winner.

National level

Judges: to be selected by the National Awards Committee Chairman. Award: banner medallions to 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place winners.
